It is anticipated the new Superintendent will assume responsibilities on August 1, 2026. The applicant must possess a valid Ohio Superintendent's license. The Superintendent must be a strong leader with integrity and high standards of ethics in all matters.

Qualifications/Responsibilities

The Elmwood Board of Education, with input from the student, staff and community forums, has identified the following qualifications as important to the position of Superintendent. The ideal candidate must be committed to the highest personal and professional standards. The person who holds this position will serve as an exemplary leader in the district and community. The Superintendent must maintain integrity and ethics in all matters. The applicant must possess a current Ohio Superintendent License (or be able to obtain one). The successful candidate will demonstrate the following leadership characteristics:

Elmwood Local Schools is a rural school district located in Northwest Ohio. The District consists of 113 square miles of land in southern Wood County and a small portion of northern Hancock County. There are six small communities that make up the district. They are: Wayne, Bloomdale, Cygnet, Jerry City, West Millgrove, and Bairdstown. The Elmwood School District is located close to Bowling Green, Fostoria, Findlay, and less than 40 miles from Toledo.

In 2000, voters approved a bond levy for a new Pre-K through 12th Grade complex. This new state of the art building opened in February of 2004. The District enjoys strong community support in the areas of academics, athletics, and extracurricular activities. We also have strong support organizations including Elementary PTO, Music Boosters, Athletic Boosters, and the FFA Alumni Association.

The District

The Elmwood School District was created from the consolidation of four small school districts in the late 1950's. The District comprises one complex that houses the elementary, middle school, and the high school. In addition, we kept the former high school building next door and turned it into a community center, which houses overflow classes and a fitness area that is used by our community.

The district has a strong tradition of academic excellence along with proud athletic programs. The district is very attentive to the needs of special needs students and has an instructor for the gifted program as well. We also offer preschool classes for students ages 4 and 5. At the other end of the spectrum, in addition to having strong college preparatory and general courses of study, Elmwood is affiliated with the Penta Career Center, which offers 30 career technical programs and Tech Prep courses of study. Both the middle and high schools host Project Lead the Way Classes in engineering. The high school has many opportunities for students to take College Credit Plus and AP courses on campus.

Forty-eight percent of EHS graduates in the Class of 2024 continued their education at colleges and universities, with 58% attaining gainful employment. Elmwood's 2025 Graduates earned \$1,353,350 in scholarships and awards to public and private colleges and universities in Ohio and across the nation.
