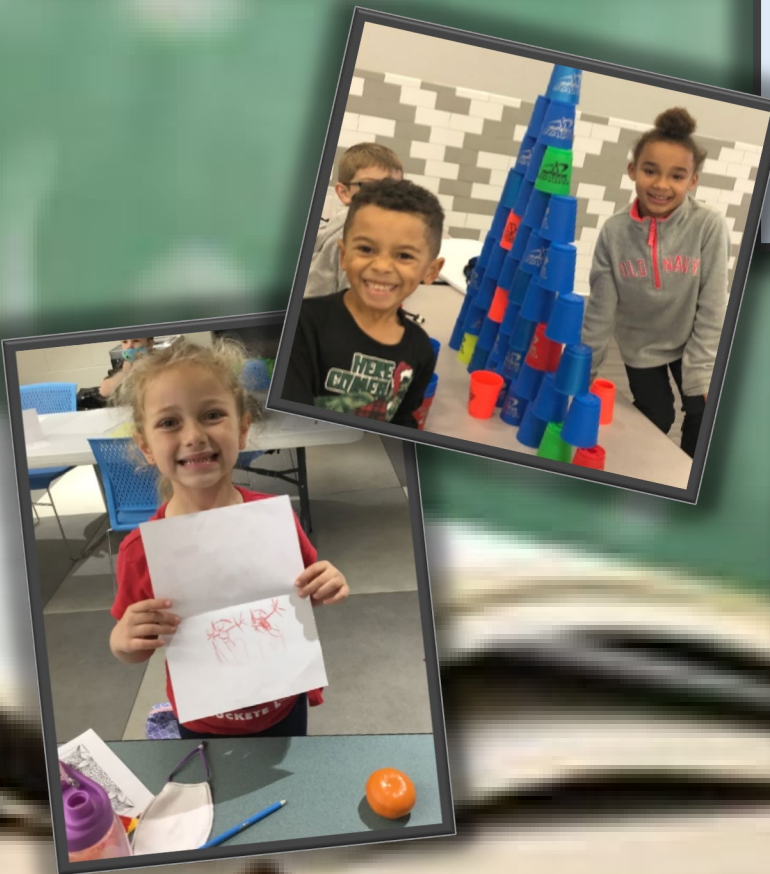

Summer School – In Person

This innovative summer intervention program is offered to nominated K-5 students 3 days per week over 5 weeks of summer break. It focuses on lessening the summer learning gap as well as prepares 2nd graders for their all-important final attempt at meeting the Third Grade Guarantee requirements. CLC manages all program details, giving certified Rossford teachers the opportunity to focus on individualized reading and math skills intervention. In addition to targeted skills practice, Summer Academy participants receive a daily snack and outdoor activity session. This program has been running for over 10 years and is a staple of the Rossford school system.

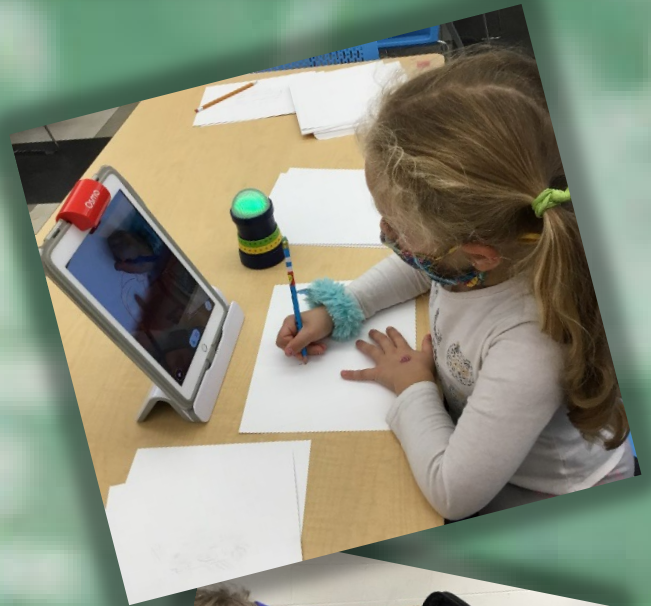

Summer School – Virtual

Our groundbreaking virtual adaptation of traditional in-person summer school. Grade level small group sessions are conducted utilizing district teachers. CLC sets up the structure- teacher expectations, student and parent expectations- as well as handles marketing, registration, supply ordering and distribution, training, human resources, payroll, and data collection. Students receive small group reading and math instruction with certified teachers, as well as assignments and feedback through Google Classroom. Virtual Summer Academy was piloted last summer with Rossford Exempted Village Schools, entitled Rossford Virtual Summer Academy. The response was overwhelmingly positive and exceeded the district's expectations.



Each Virtual Summer Academy week consists of:

- 3 fully interactive tutor sessions with trained CLC staff, consisting of grade level reading and math skills intervention, homework assistance, and SEL check-ins
- Academic and technical support to registered families as needed
- Free 'virtual kit' consisting of supplies and educational manipulatives designed to make virtual learning more tangible

Intervention – Digital

A CLC-designed fully virtual afterschool intervention package, specifically engineered to maximize learning during a hybrid or remote schedule. Grade level small group Zoom or Google Meet sessions are conducted with our trained tutors, in order to strengthen reading and math skills. Along with reading and math skills intervention, we have incorporated a homework help and SEL check-in component. We have piloted this program with Rossford Exempted Village Schools this year, beginning our 2nd this week. The program, entitled Virtual Canine Crew, is exceeding all expectations.

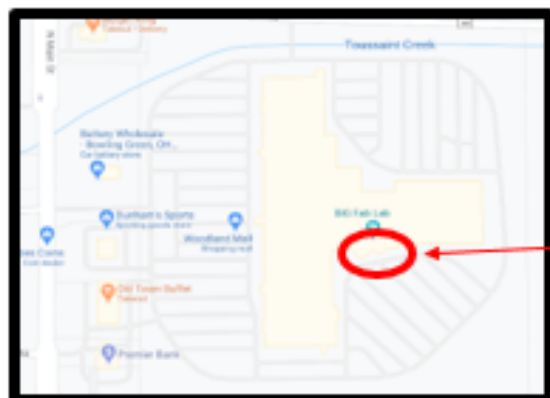

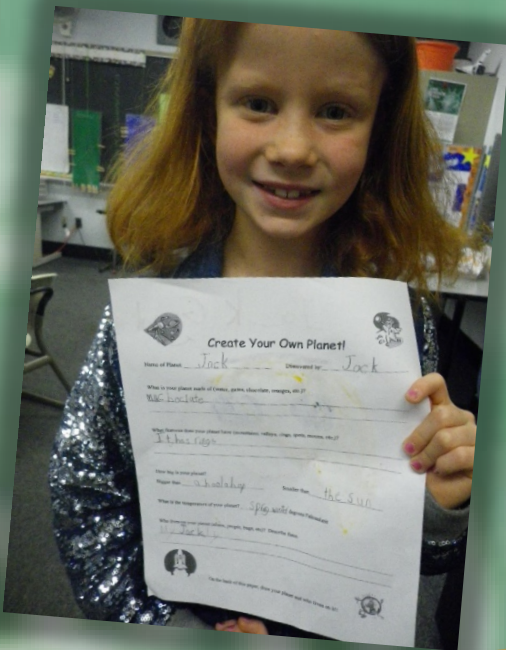

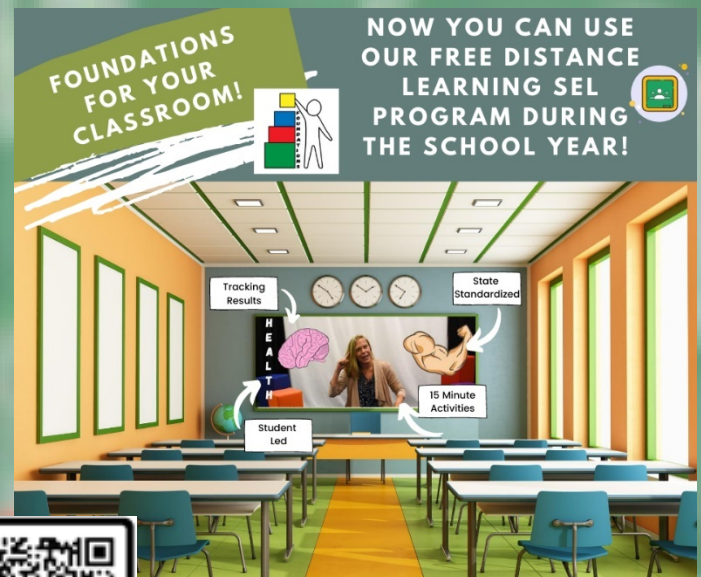
CLC America Reads Tutoring

Social Emotional Learning: Foundations - Virtual

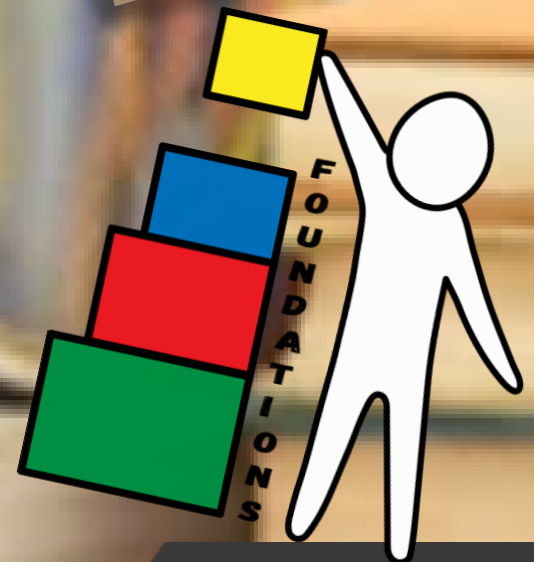
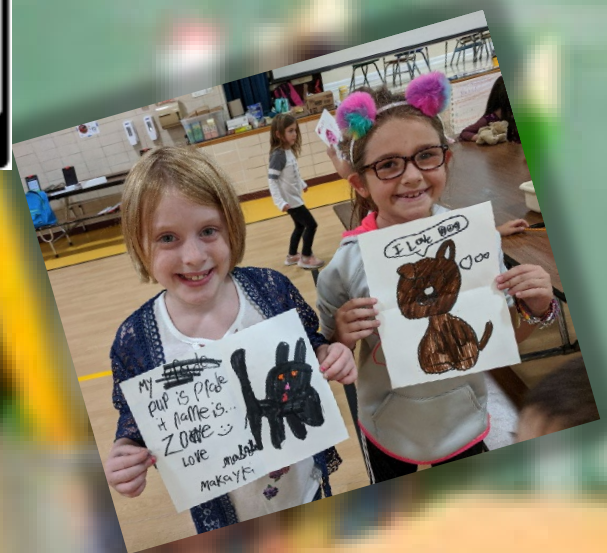

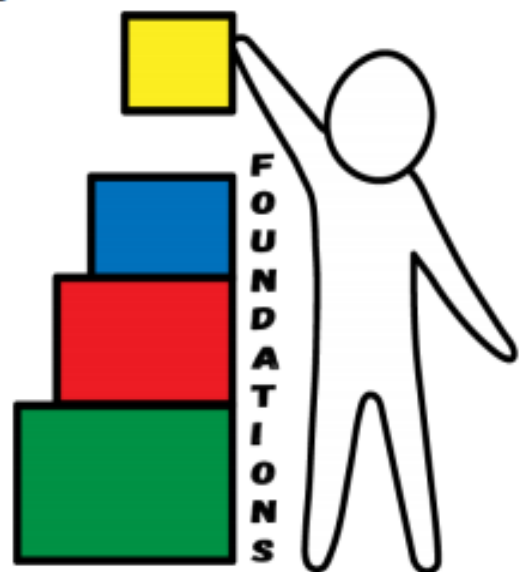
